Background

Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians Economic Development Corporation (ATNI-EDC) is developing its Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS). The final document will be used to scale ATNI-EDC, and build specific programming to be more responsive to the needs of ATNI Member Tribes.

Through a partnership grant with the Economic Development Administration (EDA), ATNI-EDC is advancing its CEDS. The CEDS is a tool that outlines a locally based, regionally driven economic development planning process. The ATNI-EDC CEDS is unique in that the defined region is dispersed.

The ATNI-EDC CEDS will adopt a two-pronged approach: one that supports ATNI Member Tribes achieve their individual economic development goals, and one that explores and facilitates the creation of an inter-tribal economy. The final ATNI-EDC CEDS will inform the future course of ATNI-EDC, and will highlight common hurdles and successes, and outline a strategy wherein we can leverage the strengths and fill the gaps. The completed ATNI-EDC CEDS will serve as a roadmap to grow and scale ATNI-EDC to be responsive to the economic development needs and priorities of ATNI Member Tribes.

This survey is being distributed to each ATNI member tribe. The survey should be completed by a Tribal leader and/or designated staff member that is knowledgeable about economic development (or a related sector) in your community. The person(s) should have a firm understanding of the current economic development landscape for your community. Multiple people may work on a single survey. Multiple copies of the completed survey from one Tribe are also welcome.

Your response in this survey will help us build out the first prong by informing targeted economic development focus areas that may be common between ATNI-Member Tribes. It will also inform your economic development needs, and allow us to create a strategy to meet those needs.

The survey is comprised of 15 questions, and should take 20-30 minutes to complete.

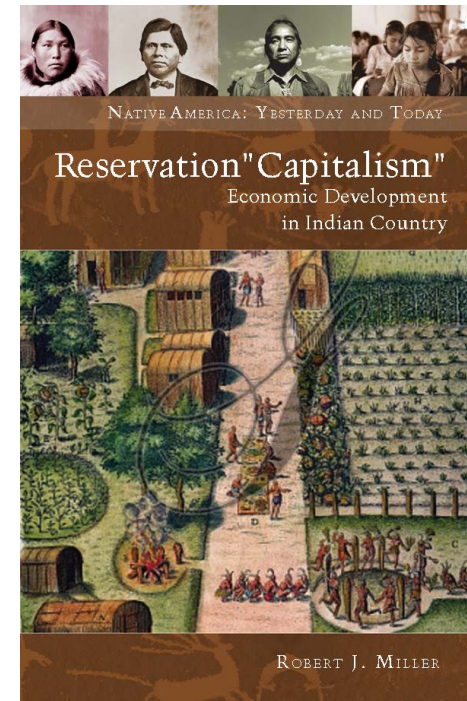
