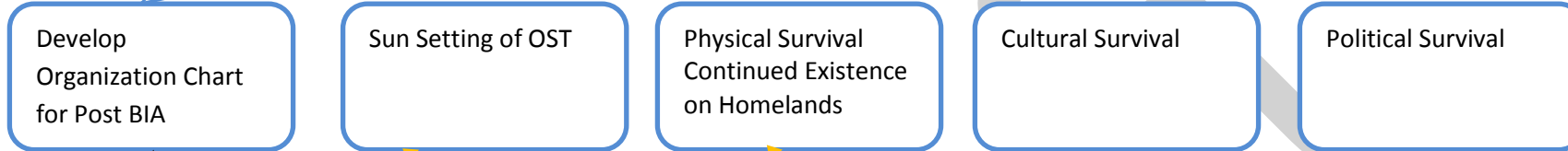

The Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indian's (ATNI) and its member tribes in the Northwest have been outspoken supporters of forward-looking trust reform, and have invested substantial time and resources in recent years advocating for related issues for trust reform legislation has been and is grounded in the commitment to maintaining the integrity of the United States' trust responsibility policy. The tribal-federal relationship is and has been historically constrained by disproportionate and underfunding of Federal government's trust responsibility that undermines any progress and consultation related to trust reform efforts. ATNI's Trust Reform Committee has developed a strategy for pursuing a Regional Strategy on Trust Reform.

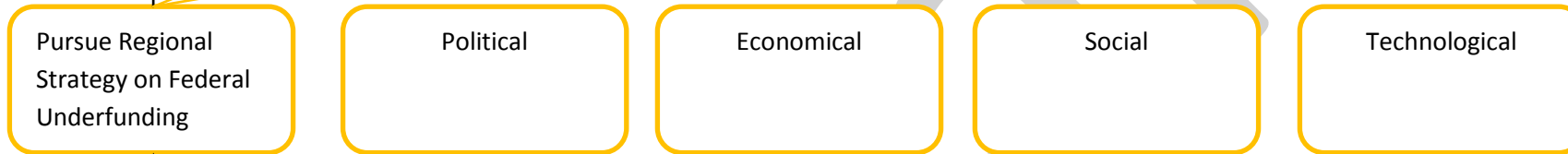

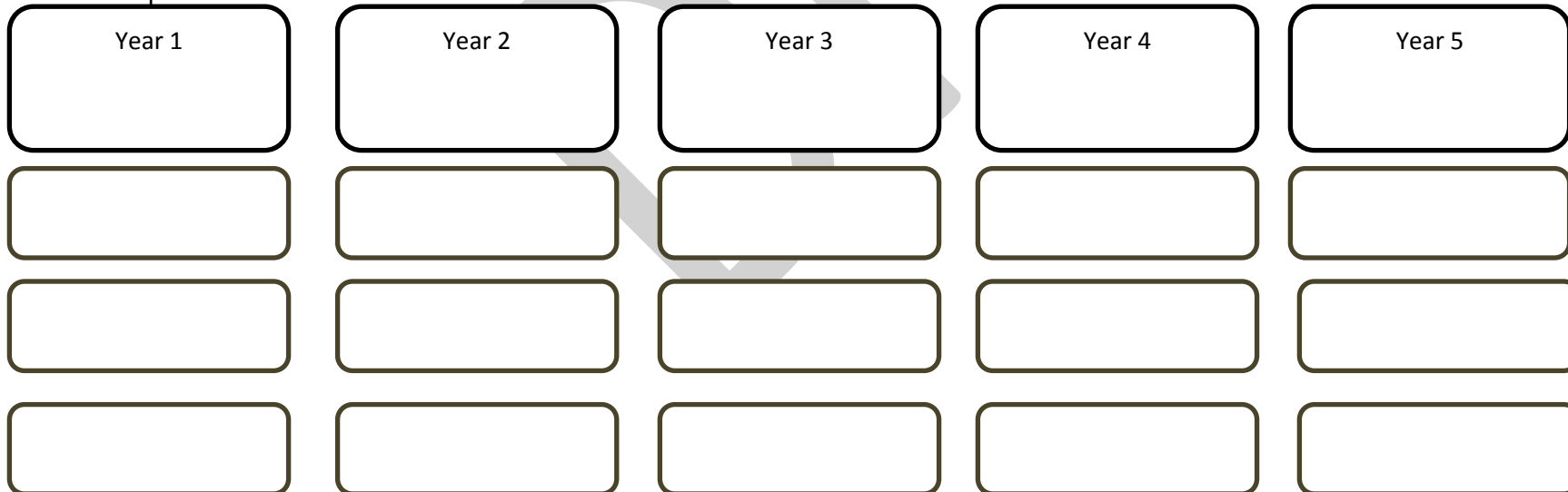
